## **Guide to Applying to the Practical Nursing Program**

Step 1:	Schedule to attend an Information Session, and complete all assignments by the given deadline.

	Select a campus, select Practical Nursing, and then find a date/time/location that works for you.	
Step 2:	Take and pass the HESI <sup>®</sup> Entrance Exam.	
	☐ Schedule your exam early to make sure you find a date/location that works for you:

	☐ Be aware of the deadline for your preferred class time/location (see next page).	
	☐ Even if you pass (all portions of the exam completed within the 2.5 hour time limit and at least a	
	70 on Reading AND 70 on Math), you may want to retake it if your score is low. Not everyone	
	who meets the minimum qualifications is accepted into the class. Acceptance is based on the	
	point system located on the next page.	
Step 3:	Upon passing the Entrance Exam, you will receive a packet with detailed directions for completing the	
	required steps. Final deadline is two weeks following the Entrance Exam/Early Bird Deadline.	
	☐ Submit ALL documentation by the Early Bird Deadline to get 15 bonus points.	
	☐ Complete the <b>application packet</b> and return it to the Jackson Campus.	
	☐ Complete an <b>online application to TCAT Jackson</b> for the appropriate term/program.	
	☐ Complete the <b>FAFSA</b> to apply for financial aid.	
	□ Submit an OFFICIAL copy of your FINAL high school, GED®, or HiSet® transcript(s),	
	along with any other transcripts/certifications noted on the next page (i.e. CNA	
	certification).	
	☐ Submit verification of immunity to the following:	
	○ Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) – 2 vaccines or a positive titer	
	○ <b>Varicella</b> – 2 vaccines or a positive titer	
Step 4:	Anxiously wait to see if you get into the program.	
-	<ul> <li>For programs that start in January, expect to find out in November.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>For programs that start in May, expect to find out in March.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>For programs that start in September, expect to find out in July.</li> </ul>	
Step 5:	IF you are accepted into the program, you will be given directions for completing the following:	
	☐ <b>Mandatory Orientation</b> – The date/time will be provided in the Acceptance Letter. This is a full	
	day of MANDATORY orientation WITH HOMEWORK that will be due before class starts.	
	☐ Acceptance (or declination) of your spot	
	☐ Background Check – If the background check shows a criminal history or other problems,	
	we cannot guarantee that you will be able to complete clinicals and, therefore, complete the	
	program.	
	□ Physical	
	☐ Additional Vaccination Documentation (in addition to MMR and varicella):	
	o <b>Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis</b> (Tdap) and/or Td booster within the last 10 years	
	<ul> <li>Hepatitis B – full vaccine series or positive titer</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Negative TB test within 6 months of program start date</li> </ul>	
	o <b>COVID vaccination</b> – Currently, most clinical sites are requiring this. Without COVID	
	vaccination, you will still able to start the program, but we cannot guarantee that you will	
	be able to complete clinicals and/or complete the program.	

o **Annual influenza vaccination** will be due in October while enrolled in the program.

## **Point System for Practical Nursing Program Admission**

REQUIRED HESI <sup>®</sup> EXAMS	POINTS EARNED		
Note: Reading, Math, and Critical Thinking portions must ALL be completed within the 2.5-hour time limit. Reading AND Math must be passed with a minimum score of 70 on each portion on the SAME attempt (no super-scoring) in order to be eligible to apply for the program.			
HESI <sup>®</sup> Reading Score			
HESI <sup>®</sup> Math Score			
BONUS POINTS			
HESI <sup>®</sup> Critical Thinking Score			
The Critical Thinking portion of the HESI® Exam is required.  Bonus points are awarded for scores ≥ 800.  800-849 = 2 Points  850-899 = 3 Points  900-949 = 4 Points  ≥ 950 = 5 Points			
Official Transcript from an Accredited Community College or University Showing Anatomy and Physiology I & II within the last 5 years (A or B in both courses)  A in Both Courses = 5 Points  A in One Course, B in the Other Course = 4 Points  B in Both Courses = 3 Points			
Attended a PN Information Session and Completed All  Follow-Up Assignments within the last year  HIGHLY RECOMMENDED BEFORE taking the Entrance Exam  15 Points			
Submitted all required documents (app, transcripts, vaccine documentation, etc.) by the Early-Bird Deadline  15 Points  Note: The candidate is not considered for selection if all required documents are not submitted by the final deadline.			
Copy of Current, Unexpired CNA (or other medical) Certification 5 Points (no additional points awarded for multiple certification	s)		
Official Transcript Showing Diploma Awarded for Completion of an Allied Health Program at TCAT within the past 3 years (N TCAT Jackson = 10 Points Other TCAT = 5 Points

## Entrance Exam/ Early Bird Deadlines:

January-Start
Programs (Brownsville)

– last Friday in
September

May-Start Programs (Jackson & Lexington) – last Friday in January

September-Start
Programs (Henderson,
Humboldt, &
Whiteville) – last
Friday in May

**Final Deadline** is two weeks after the Early Bird Deadline.
