

2021 HESI® SCHEDULE April-July

Upcoming testing dates, locations and deadlines:

Test scores are good for 2 years. Scores CANNOT be combined. Deadline to test for Sept. classes is May 28, 2021. Deadline for Brownsville Jan. 2022 class is Sept. 24, 2021.

HESI® Exam Fee - \$53.50 (As of Feb. 1, 2020) Must be scheduled online-to schedule go to <https://www.registerblast.com/tcatjackson/exam> There are no refunds on tests but you can call 24 hours prior to your test date to reschedule at no charge. Subjects include Reading Comprehension, Math, and Critical Thinking. You have 2.5 hours to complete all three tests.

Testing dates are subject to change, if you go to the website to schedule your test date and the desired test date is grayed out, that means that testing date is full. Please choose another date or another location to test. Be sure to get a head start and schedule your test early so that you have time to take and pass your test prior to the deadlines. There is no waiting period to test if you do not get your desired score the first time. You can test as many times as you want in order to get the highest score possible to increase your chances of acceptance into the Health Occupations programs.
